Monday club nights have been a huge success and may this tour be a social extension which will encourage our non-bowlers to join us soon.

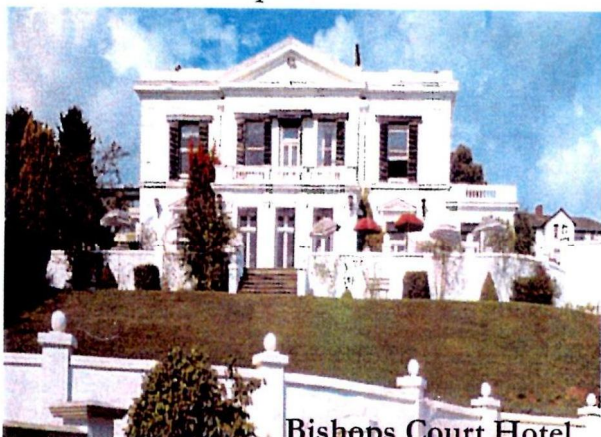

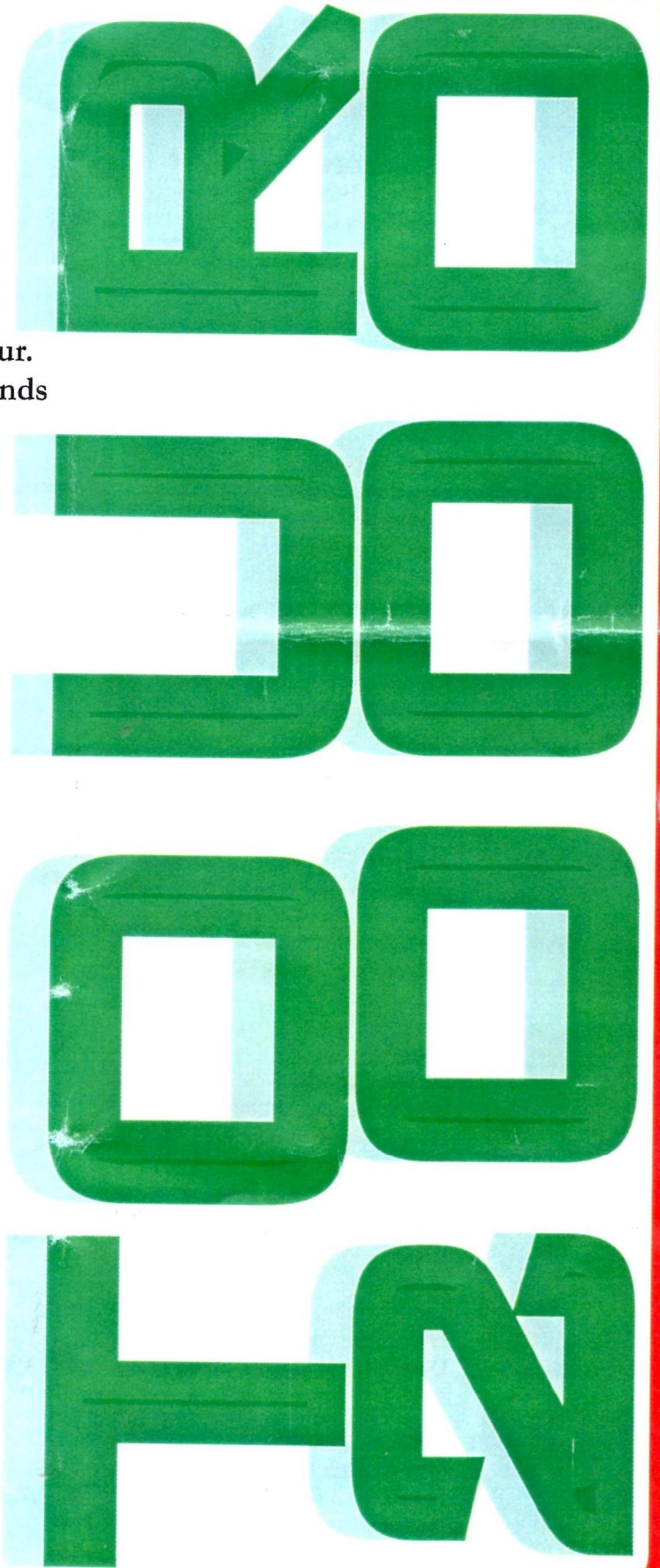

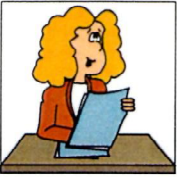
